# What is Family Worship?

### Deuteronomy 11:18–19 (The Living Bible)

So keep these commandments carefully in mind. Tie them to your hand to remind you to obey them, and tie them to your forehead between your eyes! Teach them to your children. **Talk about them when you are sitting at home, when you are out walking, at bedtime, and before breakfast!**

*Abraham was the first to do this...*



### Genesis 18:17–19 (NKJV)

And the LORD said, “Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing, since Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all **the nations of the earth** shall be blessed in him? For I have known him, in order that he may **command his children and his household** after him, that they keep the way of the LORD, to do righteousness and justice, that the LORD may bring to Abraham what He has spoken to him.”

This is why he is called **the father of the faith!** (Romans 4:16)



Genesis 12:3 (NKJV) ... And in you **all the families of the earth** shall be blessed.”
